Thank you to everyone that participated in the parent survey. We are reviewing the results and taking your suggestions to heart. Some of the suggestions were:

\*Lesson plans being sent home, so you can work with your child. I will look into a way to do this. The classes have their lesson plans in different formats. I will try to determine what is best.

\*Many parents have also asked for a teacher spotlight. I also love this idea.

\*Some parents commented on the structure of the classes. The classrooms have circle time during the day. We focus heavily on the children's social emotional development. We help them learn how to work together and be a friend, we also help them identify and understand their emotions. The classrooms also post their daily schedule at the door. \*There were some comments over security. I can tell you that codes for the doors are

coming. Soon you will all be given an individual code that can be used to access the center. \*Some had questions over lunch and snack. We are unable to provide lunch for the children because we do not have our own kitchen. The older classrooms are not able to heat up food. During lunchtime those teachers are alone and it would make supervision difficult. We are switching the Cinnamon Toast crunch out for cheerios so there is a less sugary option.

\*Lastly, turnover has been a concern. Many of our teachers have been here for years and we LOVE that! Other classes it seems the turnover is more frequent. Our afternoon teachers tend to be students, so as schedules change and they gradate they leave us faster. We are in the process of filling a couple of positions. We are very sad to say Ms. Sarah is leaving us to focus on her education and Ms. Yarely is moving. We are interviewing trying to find the best fit. Ms. Jessica also recently graduated from college and is moving away. Her position has been filled we are very excited to have Ms. Cynthia starting in Infant B.
